Construction Site Sign Standard

(Updated: 1/25/10)

The project sign shall be a 4'x8' MDO plywood panel with a Yale Blue* background and white vinyl lettering per the University Printer's specifications. Depending on the construction site, the sign shall be pole-mounted on two 4"x4" wood posts or mounted directly to the construction fencing. The posts and the rear side of the sign shall be painted Yale Blue.

The final fabrication file is prepared by University Printer John Gambell (as an eps outline file); see procedure below.

- PM inserts project text into draft Word sign document and sends to UPr.
- UPr reviews text and sends draft pdf fabrication file to PM, with comments, for review.
- PM sends corrections to UPr.
- UPr sends final eps fabrication file to PM.
- PM and CM determine whether a pole-mounted or fence-mounted sign is needed.
- PM sends final eps fabrication file to CM, with color and mounting specifications, for bidding to sign companies.
- CM oversees installation by sign company.

* Please note that the sign company will need to be provided with specifications re: Yale Blue. The sign company may be required to provide UPr with a sample of Yale Blue before proceeding with sign fabrication.
